Every individual in the Club should at all times show respect and understanding for their rights, safety and welfare, and conduct themselves in a way that reflects the principles of the Club and the guidelines contained in the Club's code of ethics.

Howth Celtic has accepted its moral and legal responsibilities, to ensure that children enjoy soccer in safety. Howth Celtic has implemented the Football Association of Ireland code of ethics and good practice for children's soccer. By implementing this code Howth Celtic has policies and procedures in place which cover – coach/volunteer/manager Garda vetting, bullying, disciplinary complaints and appeals, accident recording, code of ethics for players/coaches/managers/parents and spectators, parent contract, mission statement, photographic/video footage, reporting of child abuse and child protection. Howth Celtic has formed links with the Garda Siochana and the Health Board. All persons within the Club actively involved with children will be Garda vetted.

In implementing the FAI code Howth Celtic has appointed Colette Mc Kenny as the Club's children's officer. Any complaint or concern a Player/Parent/Guardian may have can be directed to the Club children's officer, who will follow the Club's procedures. All Howth Celtic Coaches/Managers have a full copy of Club policies and procedures, which can be viewed at any time by Parents/Guardians.

Any Parent/Guardian wishing their child to play on a team above their age group must complete Parent/Guardian consent form and return with player registration form to the Club. NO PLAYER WILL BE PERMITTED TO PLAY FOR HOWTH CELTIC AFC ABOVE THEIR AGE GROUP WITHOUT PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT FORM. PARENT /GUARDIAN MUST SIGN CLUB PARENT/GUARDIAN CONTRACT AND ALSO SIGN TO ABIDE BY THE CLUB CODE OF ETHICS, POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO ENABLE THEIR CHILD TO PLAY FOR HOWTH CELTIC.
